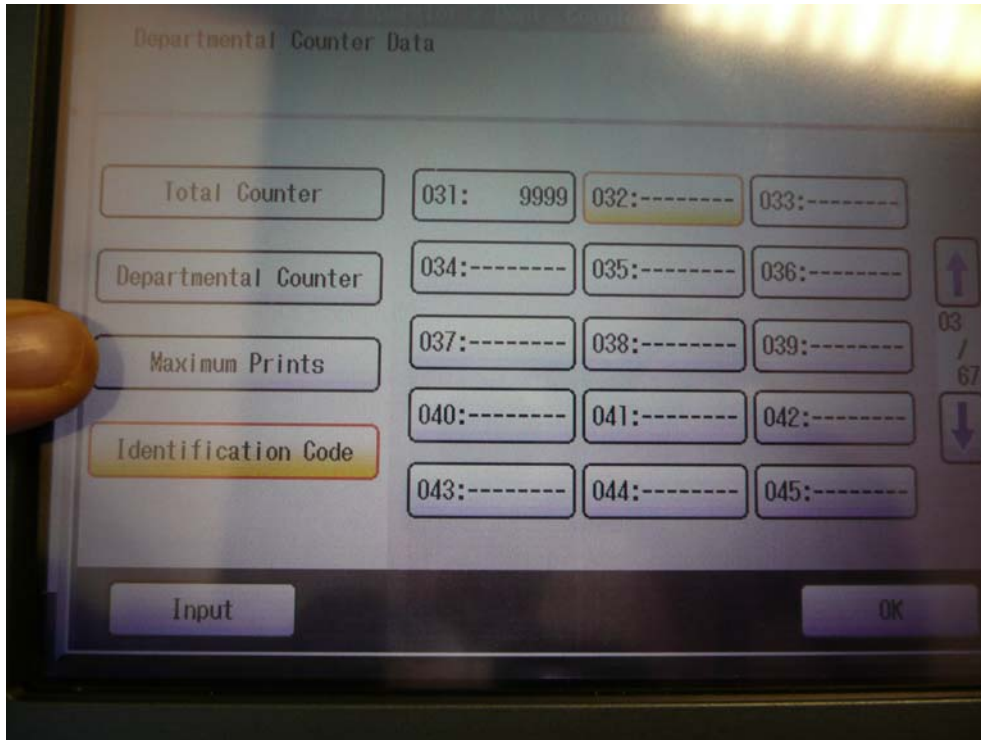
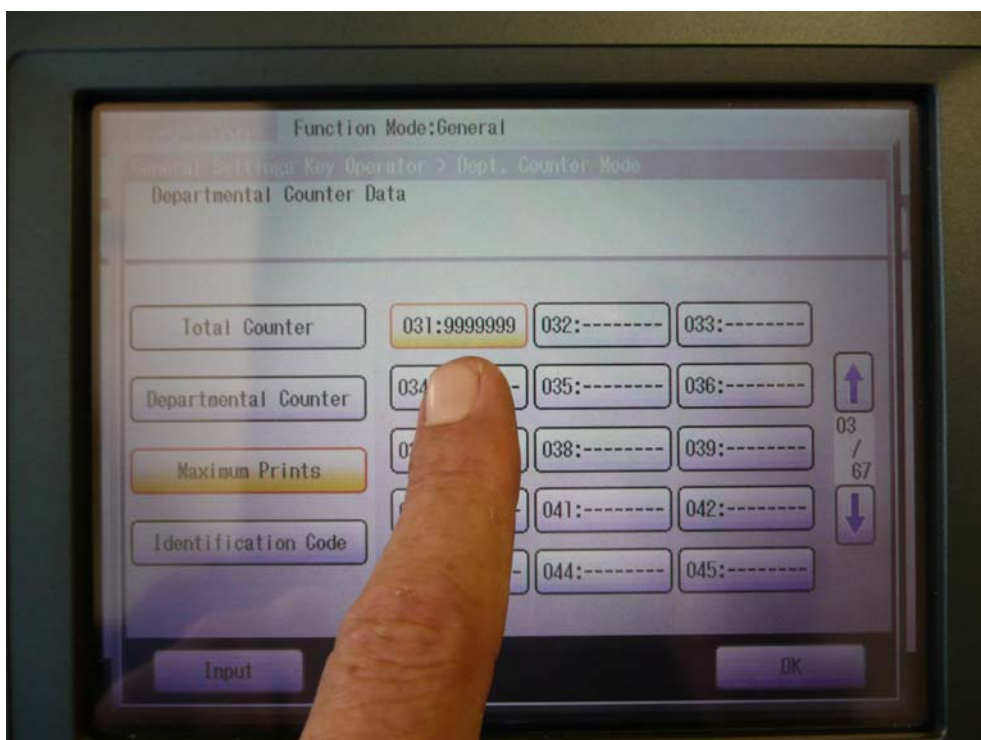


To restrict colour usage on an ID code on your Colour Photocopier

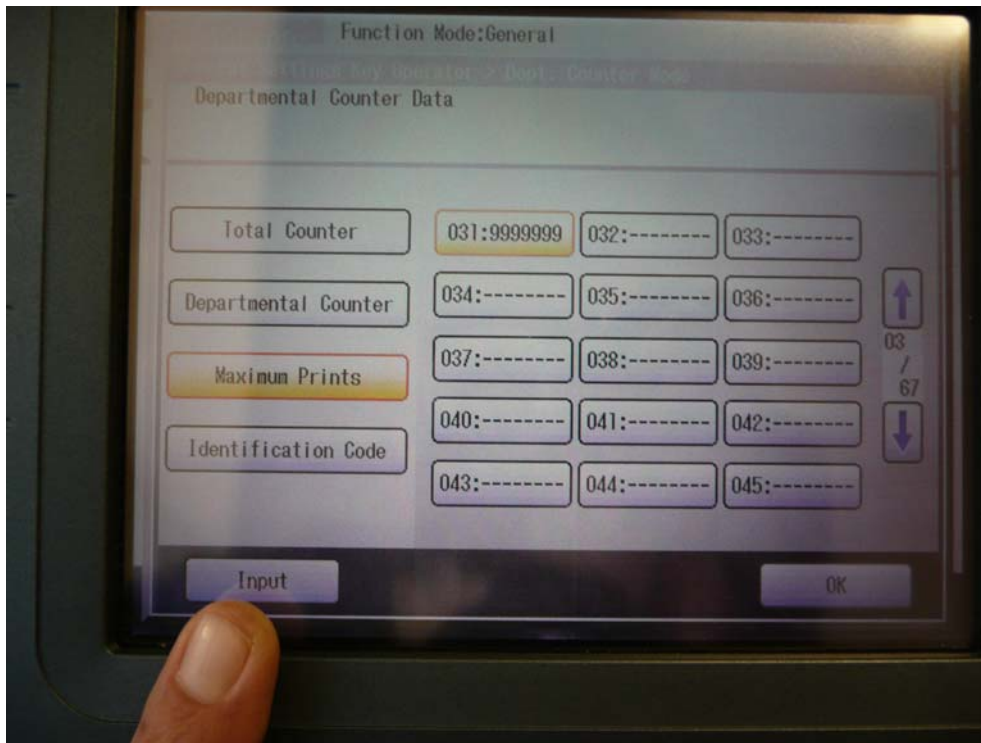
**Please refer to “How to print off the ID code list readings from your Colour Copier.” This will guide you to the Department data screen as shown below.
Press the Maximum Prints tab as shown below.**



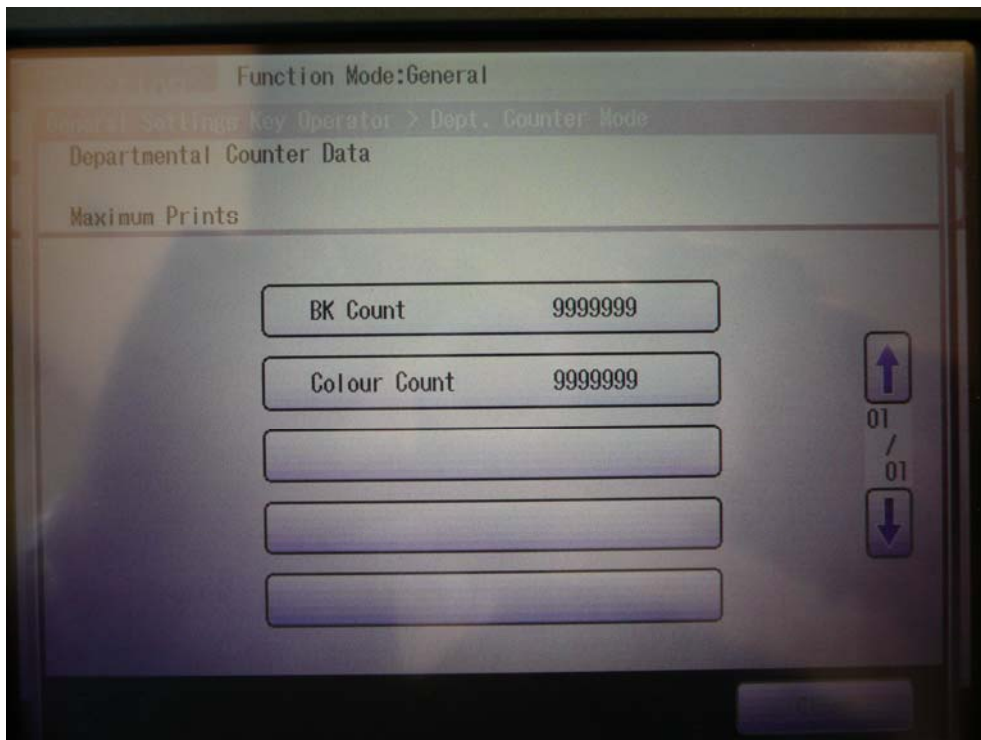
Press the tab of the ID code that you would like to restrict as shown below. The tab will now be highlighted in yellow.



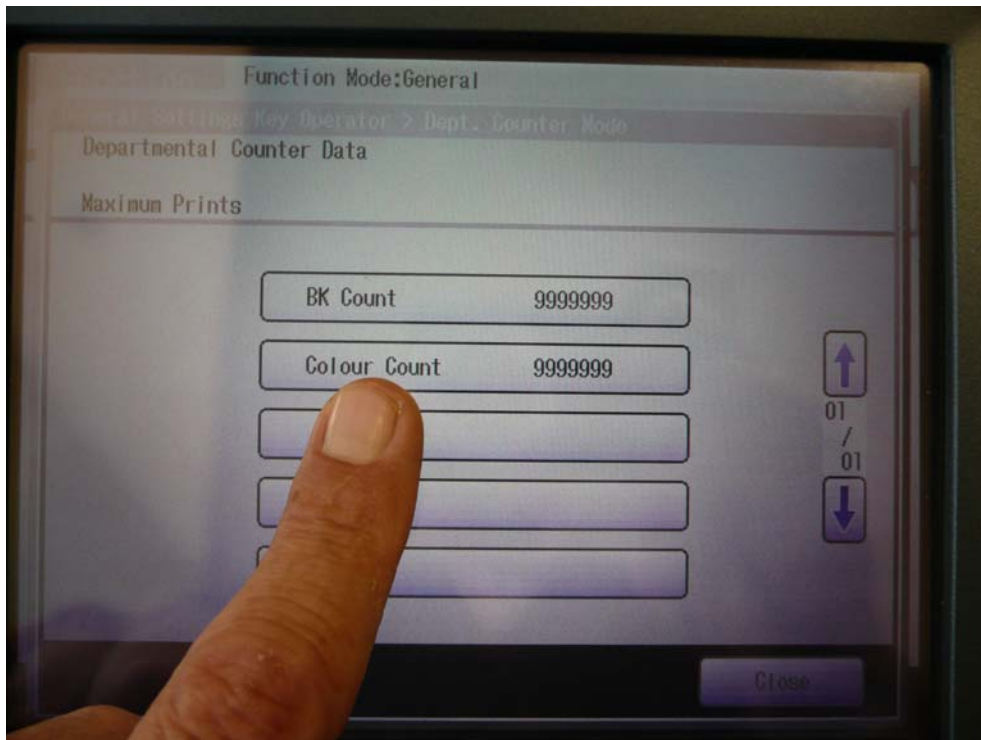
Press the input tab as shown below.



You will now see the screen below that displays Black (BK) count and below colour count.



Press on the colour count tab on the screen as below.



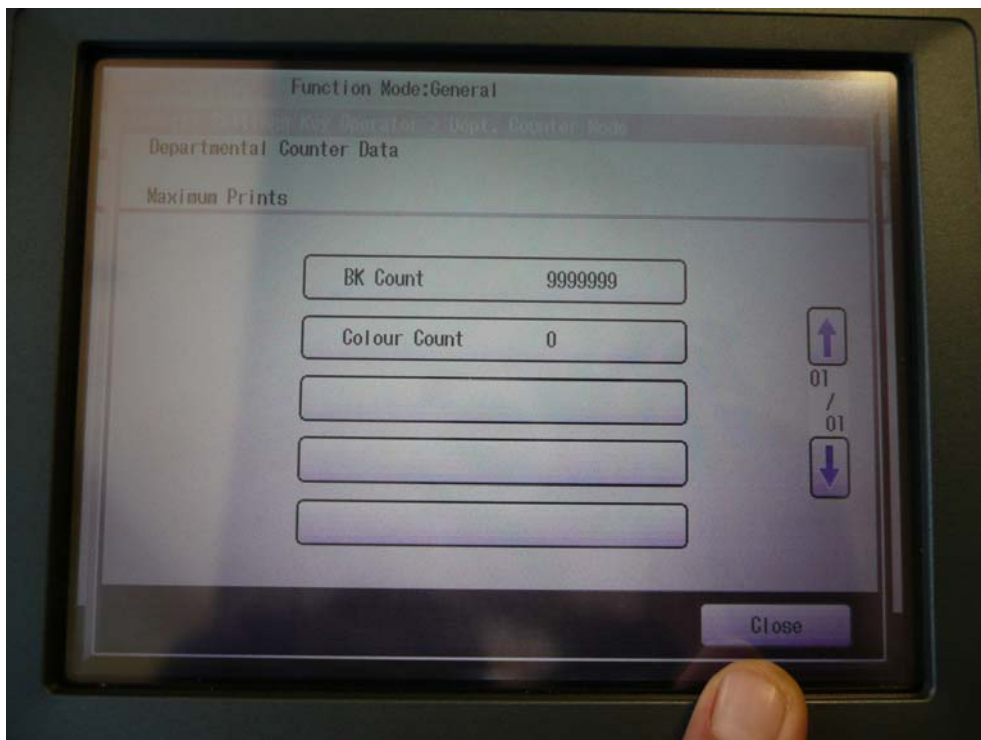
This will open up a screen as below that will allow you to enter a figure. If you want to totally restrict the ID code from being able to copy in colour then enter 0. If you just want to limit the use for colour then enter the value of your choice.



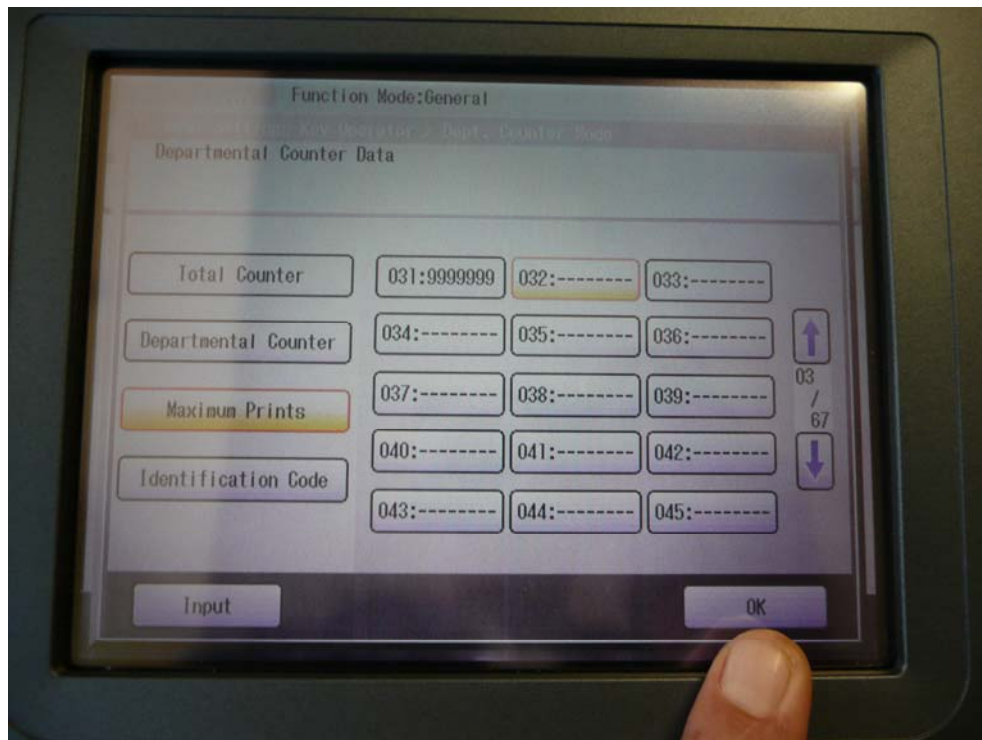
Once you have entered the value of your choice press the OK tab on the Screen as below.



You will now see a confirmation screen with the values for black and colour copying. The screen below is set for unlimited black copying but no colour copying. Press the close tab.



Once you have finished entering your data press the OK tab on the screen as below.



Press the yellow reset button on the control panel to return to your normal screen.

If an ID code tries to copy a colour copy that has been restricted the following message will be displayed.
